

Obtaining CE Credit for Live Seminars and Printing CE Certificates and/or Statements of Credit - PHARMACY

Thank you for attending. To receive CE credit, the attendance code for each seminar must be redeemed BEFORE it expires and the program evaluation must be completed. See instructions below.

All attendance codes must be redeemed by **Monday, October 29th at 11:59 PM.**

Note: The attendance codes **will expire** after this date.

1. Go to www.belmont.edu/pharmacy/ce.html and click on the **red** “click here to access online CE site” button.
2. Log on to the Belmont Pharmacy Continuing Education website by clicking “Sign In” in the bottom right corner.
Note: If this is your first time to use our CE website, you will need to first set up an account by clicking “Sign In” in the bottom right corner, then click “Sign Up” and follow instructions. **Please be sure to enter your NABP ePID and DOB in order for CE to process correctly.** After you enter your information, you should receive an e-mail with a confirmation link. Please click on this link to activate your account. (Check spam folder for the e-mail if you do not see it)
3. Click on “Register” in the top right corner.
4. Click on the link for “2018 TOPA Annual Meeting”
5. Each session has a **blue** “Click here to access evaluation” button. For each session you attended, click here, then click enroll (top right corner).
6. When prompted, enter the unique attendance code and complete the seminar evaluation.
7. You may print a certificate, if desired, by clicking the green “print certificate” button (You may have to click Refresh for button to appear). A full transcript of your CE activities can be obtained at www.nabp.net on your CPE Monitor profile.

It is recommended that you check your NABP CPE Monitor e-profile database after the completion of any CE activity to ensure that your credits are posted.
